


Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions in Mexico

In April 2025, **14 transactions** were announced in Mexico, **staying consistent** versus the prior month. Compared to the same period last year, the volume of transactions decreased by **8 transactions**.

of Transactions per Month



Annual Transactions (US\$ million)




Summary of Transactions Abroad by Mexican Companies

Disclosed Deal Volume by Mexican Companies Abroad


of Transactions per Month



Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions by Industry


The **financial** industry led the domestic M&A activity in Mexico, with **9 announced transactions** as of April 2025, which represents **15.3%** of the total announced transactions.

The **services and industrial** sectors led M&A activity by Mexican companies abroad, each accounting for **3 announced transactions** as of April 2025, representing **21.4%** of the total announced transactions.
