


Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions in Mexico

In June 2025, **17 transactions** were announced in Mexico, increasing by **3 transactions** versus the prior month. Compared to the same period last year, the volume of transactions remained the same.

of Transactions per Month



Disclosed Deal Volume and Value in Mexico


Annual Transactions (US\$ million)


Disclosed Deal Volume by Mexican Companies in Foreign Geographies# of Transactions per Month



Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions by Industry


The **mining** industry led the domestic M&A activity in Mexico, with **16** announced transactions as of June 2025, representing **17.8%** of the total announced transactions.

The **consumer** sector led M&A activity by Mexican companies in foreign geographies, with **7 announced transactions** as of June 2025, representing **31.8%** of the total announced transactions.
