


Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions in Mexico


In March 2025, 14 transactions were announced in Mexico, decreasing by 2 transactions versus the prior month. Compared to the same period last year, the volume of transactions increased by 2 transactions.




Summary of Transactions Abroad by Mexican Companies


In March 2025, 4 transactions were announced by Mexican companies abroad, increasing by 1 transaction versus the prior month. Compared to the same period last year, the volume of transactions decreased by **3 transactions**.



Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions by Industry


The **real estate** industry led the domestic M&A activity in Mexico, with **7** announced transactions as of March 2025, which represents 15.6% of the total announced transactions.






