


### Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions in Mexico

# of Transactions per Month




Annual Transactions (US\$ million)

In May 2025, **6 transactions** were announced by Mexican companies in foreign geographies, increasing by **1 transaction** versus the prior month. Compared to the same period last year, the volume of transactions increased by **5 transactions**.


**Disclosed Deal Volume by Mexican Companies in Foreign Geographies**# of Transactions per Month



### Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions by Industry


The **mining** industry led the domestic M&A activity in Mexico, with **13** announced transactions as of May 2025, representing **17.8%** of the total announced transactions.
