


Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions in Mexico

of Transactions per Month



Annual Transactions (US\$ million)




Summary of Transactions Abroad by Mexican-based Companies


Disclosed Deal Volume by Mexican Companies Abroad

of Transactions per Month





Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions by Industry


The **real estate** industry led the domestic M&A activity in Mexico, with **20 announced transactions** as of June 2024, which represents **21.3%** of the total announced transactions.

The **consumer** sector led M&A activity by Mexican companies abroad, with **9 announced transactions** as of June 2024, representing **42.9%** of the total announced transactions.
