


Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions in Mexico

In March 2024, 12 transactions were announced in Mexico, decreasing by 7 transactions versus the prior month. Compared to the same period last year, the volume of transactions decreased by 3 transactions.

of Transactions per Month



Annual Transactions (US\$ million)




Summary of Transactions Abroad by Mexican-based Companies

Disclosed Deal Volume by Mexican Companies Abroad


of Transactions per Month




Disclosed Deal Volume and Value by Mexican Companies Abroad Annual Transactions (US\$ million)

The **real estate** industry led the domestic M&A activity in Mexico, with **10** announced transactions as of March 2024, which represents **24.4%** of the total announced transactions.


